PLAYER AWARDS & PERFORMANCE

(Updated January 2018)

SECTION PLAYER OF THE YEAR

1. Performance points will be awarded to eligible Section members and approved tournament players.
2. Events receive a power rating, (i.e. – more points based on the importance of an event).
3. Ties are calculated the same as monies earned – possible split/tie.
4. There will be no Player of the Year points awarded in US Open Qualifying and Ozark District events.
5. Player of the Year points will only be awarded in Pro Pro events that have a Best Ball format. Points are awarded based on individual score not team score.
6. Class A Assistant professionals playing in the Section / PNC Championship will receive regular Player of the Year points, not Assistant Player of the Year points. .
7. Associates will receive regular Player of the Year points and Associate Player of the Year points in the Assistant Championship. Class A Assistant professionals playing in the Assistant Championship will receive Assistant Player of the Year points, not regular Player of the Year points.
8. If a PGA member or approved tournament player is suspended for any reason during the tournament season (March – October), points earned by the individual shall be void.
9. A minimum of 10 points will be awarded to all participants, per event, who register on time and do not --- No Show, No Card, and/or Withdraw. These points will be awarded to only those participants not finishing in the “Official” per event point total.
10. If a PGA member or associate is playing in a National event (National PNC, National Senior PNC and National Assistants Championship) which conflicts with a section sanctioned points event, the player will still receive 300 points for playing, an additional 200 points for making the cut and another 400 points for finishing in the top 20.
11. If a senior player chooses to play from the senior tees, he/she may not receive Section Player of the Year points for the event.

SENIOR PLAYER OF THE YEAR

1. Must be at least age 50 to be eligible for points.
2. Performance points to be awarded to eligible Section members and approved tournament players.
3. Ties are calculated the same as monies earned – possible split/tie.
4. If a PGA member or approved tournament player is suspended for any reason during the tournament season (March – October), points earned by the individual shall be void.
5. A minimum of 10 points will be awarded to all participants, per event, who register on time and do not --- No Show, No card, and/or Withdraw. These points will be awarded to only those participants not finishing in the “Official” per event point total.
6. If a PGA member or associate is playing in a National event (National PNC, National Senior PNC and National Assistants Championship) which conflicts with a section sanctioned event, the player will still receive 300 points for playing, an additional 200 points for making the cut and another 400 points for finishing in the top 20.

- Senior players will be awarded both Regular POY points and Senior POY points if electing to play from the regular tees. If the senior elects to play from the senior tees, only Senior POY points will be awarded.

ASSOCIATE/ASSISTANT PLAYER OF THE YEAR

- Individual must be registered in the PGA Professional Golf Management program.
- Be eligibly employed.
- Performance points to be awarded to eligible associates and assistants.
- Events receive a power rating, (i.e. – more points based on the importance of an event).
- Ties are calculated the same as monies earned – possible split/tie.
- If an associate is suspended for any reason during the tournament season (March – October), points earned by the associate shall be void.

7. Ten (10) points will be awarded to all participants, per event, who register on time and do not --- No Show, No card, and/or Withdraw. These points will be awarded to only those participants not finishing in the "Official" per event total.
8. If a PGA member or associate is playing in a National event (National PNC, National Senior PNC and National Assistants Championship) which conflicts with a section sanctioned event, the player will still receive 300 points for playing, an additional 200 points for making the cut and another 400 points for finishing in the top 20.

Harold "Jug" McSpaden Award

A. Determines the "overall" Section scoring average champion

1. Must have a minimum of eight (8) rounds of individual stroke play in sanctioned or sponsored events within the boundaries of the Midwest Section. Team scores do not apply.
2. Each additional round beyond the minimum rounds played in sanctioned or sponsored events will count towards an individual's stroke average.
3. If a PGA member or associate is suspended for any reason during the tournament season (March – October), scoring averages earned by the individual shall be void.

4. Failure to turn in a scorecard after a round will automatically disqualify a participant from eligibility as scoring champion.
5. A “Withdraw” from a tournament without a medical or emergency circumstance will automatically disqualify a participant from eligibility as scoring champion. A medical or emergency circumstance must be communicated and approved by the Tournament Committee or Executive Director.
